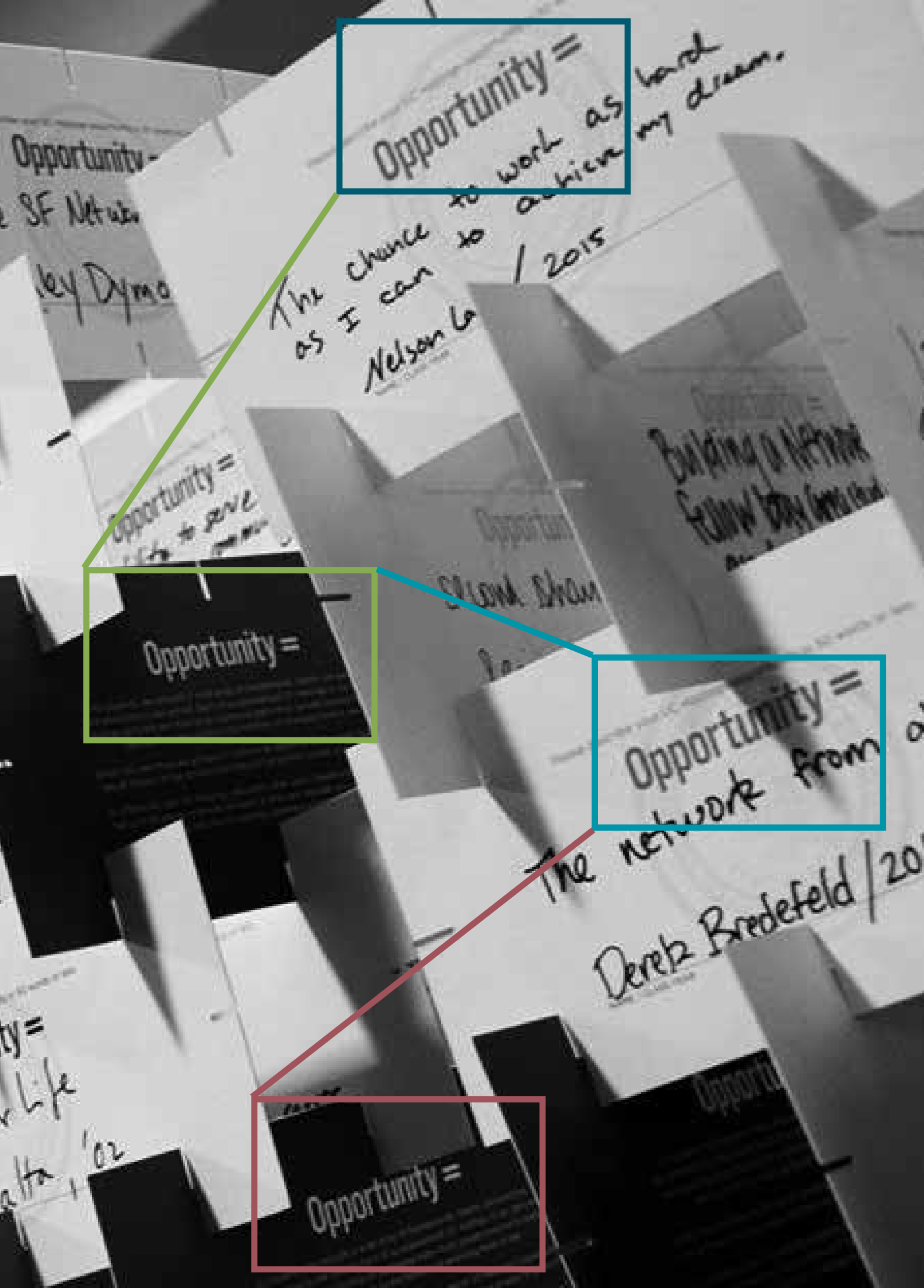

# OPPORTUNITY = IMMERSION

It was the summer of 1974. The impeachment of Richard Nixon was under way. The environmental movement was gaining momentum. And thanks to his UC Hastings education, Basil Plastiras was in Washington, DC, watching history unfold. "After my second year, a UC Hastings alum helped me get a job at the Federal Power Commission, where I oversaw compliance with environmental statutes," Plastiras recalls. "It was an eventful summer."

Plastiras honors that opportunity by helping to ensure the ongoing excellence of a UC Hastings education. He serves on the UC Hastings Foundation Board of Trustees and chaired the law school's 2015 reunion campaign, which connected him with students and alums across generations. "Whenever I interact with students, I return to my practice with increased enthusiasm and appreciation for the opportunities I've been given," he says. Plastiras pays it forward with unrestricted gifts to the UC Hastings Fund. "To me, UC Hastings is a lifelong commitment," he says. "Whatever I've achieved has come through the skills I developed in law school and with the aid of my degree."

Allyssa Villanueva remembers what it was like to be a 1L. "When I was feeling isolated," she recalls, "Dean Wu referred me to faculty who shared my interests and experiences." Those connections facilitated ideal opportunities for someone with deep social justice and community service ambitions. Now a 3L, Villanueva has interned for civil rights attorney John L. Burris, who represented the family of Oscar Grant. She has visited earthquake-stricken Haiti with the law school's annual delegation. She also externed with the Oakland City Attorney's labor and employment division through the Local Government Clinic.

Villanueva knows these experiences would have been impossible without alumni investments in opportunity. To build an enduring culture of philanthropy at UC Hastings, she encourages participation in the Student Giving Campaign, through which her peers support the programs they care about most. Villanueva also serves as an ambassador to the Faculty & Staff Giving Campaign, which matches student contributions. "Gifts to these programs give students like me the support we need to succeed, during and after our time at UC Hastings," Villanueva says.

The NoVo Foundation believes girls are one of the most powerful and untapped forces on the planet. Yet, around the world, women and girls face threats of violence every day and sometimes flee their homes to escape persecution in many forms, from domestic abuse to the threat of genital mutilation.

Dedicated to collaborating to end violence against women and girls, the foundation has made a transformative investment in UC Hastings' Center for Gender & Refugee Studies. Led by Professor Karen Musalo, who has litigated precedent-setting cases on gender asylum, CGRS pushes for policy change and serves as a resource for attorneys across the country. The NoVo Foundation's generous gift supports the broad scope of CGRS's work, from technical assistance and training to strategic litigation to policy advocacy.

The result is impact — including asylum for more women, children, and LGBT individuals fleeing persecution — and opportunity — for attorneys working pro bono in this important field, and for law students drawn to CGRS and UC Hastings' reputation for research, advocacy, and influence.

Charanjit Brahma's UC Hastings education was about connecting the dots. "I came from a background in engineering and wanted to transition to a career in law," Brahma says. At UC Hastings, transformative opportunities appeared: Mentors like Professor John Diamond helped Brahma crack the code of legal writing. Moot Court competitions honed skills of argument and built Brahma's confidence and impact. And from these connected dots, a clear path and a successful career emerged.

"I decided long ago that I would give back to UC Hastings once my student loans were paid off," says Brahma. He puts that ambition into action as a member of the Alumni Board of Governors, with a focus on building connections among alumni, students, and the law school itself. Brahma brought Washington, DC-area alums together to create a regional scholarship fund supporting students who wish to work in DC for the summer or a semester. By putting these often-unpaid work opportunities within reach, the scholarship fund helps build the law school's legacy of public service.

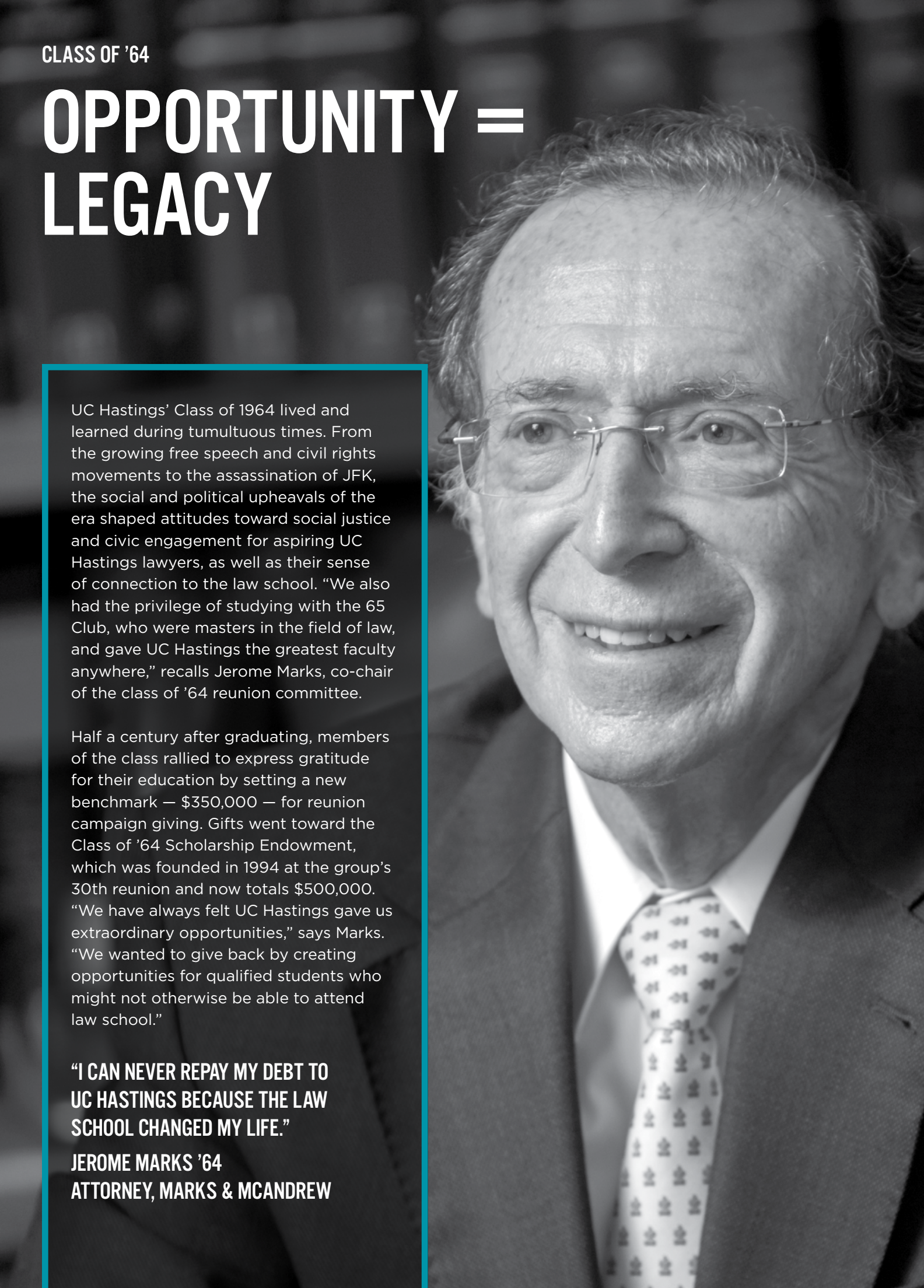
OPPORTUNITY =

UC Hastings' Class of 1964 lived and learned during tumultuous times. From the growing free speech and civil rights movements to the assassination of JFK, the social and political upheavals of the era shaped attitudes toward social justice and civic engagement for aspiring UC Hastings lawyers, as well as their sense of connection to the law school. "We also had the privilege of studying with the 65 Club, who were masters in the field of law, and gave UC Hastings the greatest faculty anywhere," recalls Jerome Marks, co-chair of the class of '64 reunion committee.

Half a century after graduating, members of the class rallied to express gratitude for their education by setting a new benchmark — \$350,000 — for reunion campaign giving. Gifts went toward the Class of '64 Scholarship Endowment, which was founded in 1994 at the group's 30th reunion and now totals \$500,000. "We have always felt UC Hastings gave us extraordinary opportunities," says Marks. "We wanted to give back by creating opportunities for qualified students who might not otherwise be able to attend law school."

Making UC Hastings their own, Woodruff and Matayoshi took advantage of opportunities that have shaped their careers. For Woodruff, it was trying real cases as a third-year student in the Criminal Practice Clinic. For Matayoshi, who serves on the law school's Alumni Board of Governors, it was being part of the top-ranked Moot Court team. “That experience

honed all the skills essential to being a lawyer, particularly when you're first starting out,” she recalls.

Woodruff and Matayoshi have spent virtually their entire careers at Farella Braun + Martel, where both now work in the Complex Litigation Department and Woodruff chairs the Appellate Litigation Practice. Together they lead the UC Hastings Challenge team at their firm. How did they achieve 100 percent participation? “I remind fellow alums that this is our opportunity to pay forward our personal success,” says Woodruff. “I feel I owe my career to my UC Hastings degree. Knowing that, it's easy to give back.”
